

Sequence for ICS messages:

Cargonaut needs to receive FFM, FWB and FHL messages to make a complete ENS message for Customs.

To be able to make a complete ENS message we need to receive the FWB and FHL messages **before** we receive the FFM message.

After receiving the FFM message we are going to send the ENS message to Customs 8 hours before arrival time.

We check all AWB numbers that are mentioned in the FFM message for received FWB and FHL messages

If we have received the FWB and FHL messages we can put the data in the ENS message.

If the FWB and FHL messages are not (yet) received we will put "Unknown" in the data fields of these AWB numbers in the ENS message.

If the FWB and FHL messages are received after we have send the ENS message to Customs, we will send "update ENS" messages for each FWB and or FHL message. If FFM is received in the final 8 hours, ENS message is immediately sent.
